





Memoires of a Bubbleman...

First of all, what is a Bubbleman? I am a Bubbleman. Actually my a.k.a. is Mega Bubble Man and here's my story.

In the summer of 1992, in Utica, NY, I was asked by a friend of mine to join him and his son for a fun time at a bubble show during the Good Ole Summer Time Program; a town-wide event. A bubble show? I had no idea what we were in for, but it sounded quite novel. The performer was introduced as Professor Suds! He created small bubbles like anyone else, but he put bubbles inside of bubbles, juggled them and created a beautiful carousel bubble work of art. We were amazed! While the performance progressed, I heard a whisper in my mind, "You could do something with this." Hmmm. What could this mean? Do something with bubbles? So I began taking notes on the bubbleman's show. The next two years I spent time in research and development. I was

inspired to make really big bubbles so it would be different than the show I saw. So I tested out several bubble formulas and created bubble wands of many sizes. One other inspiration was to create a storyline and a place where each bubble wand would be a character from the imaginary “World of Bubblopolis!”



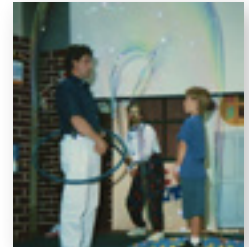
The very first show was at the Children’s Museum in downtown Utica. My audience would be 2 year olds. If I made any mistakes, who would know? It was a success! Everything worked great. I was on to “something.” Just like I had heard in my mind two years before. But who had spoken that to me? My imagination or a higher power? After all, this was wholesome fun.

It was quite a journey from that point onward. People caught on and word of mouth opened

doors all over Utica and Rome. Every year the amount of gigs doubled. It was a lot of fun doing birthday parties.



A pivotal point came when I had a realization. What was the real reason for performing? The shows were great fun, but there seemed to be a deeper purpose behind it all. I prayed, paused and pursued. One day I came upon a children’s Bible in my closet and in the first few pages I noticed that they were completely colored... gold, red, green, white and black; all with no text. This was unusual for a Bible. I found out that this was called a Wordless Bible. Each color represented a portion of the gospel of Jesus Christ. Let me explain. Black, the “thinnest” color in a bubble, represents our moral failings. The Bible calls



it sin. When someone sins, it moves us away from God. However, the answer to sin is quite simple. God knew we had a problem of sinning all the time, so He sent His Son Jesus Christ to earth to display a sinless life; one that we could follow as an example. He did all kinds



of miracles and preached about God's love for us. Many followed Him. The Jews, thought He was the Messiah that would fight the Romans and give them back peace in their land. Jesus surprised them and didn't fight, but did the opposite.

He gave up His life for the people. The way this happened was Him being crucified on a cross; this was a criminal's death. The Jews tried to understand why this happened; and they hid from the Roman soldiers. In three days though, Jesus was resurrected from the grave. One of His disciples went to His grave and found Him alive! She realized that He

truly is the Messiah. Jesus had done what His Heavenly Father asked Him to do... to die for His people so that they might live. Not just an earthly life, but an abundant life here. And then, when they die, have a new life in heaven for eternity! Jesus shed His blood and life as a sacrifice for mankind so that they could be with Him forever. He only asked for everyone to believe in Him as their Lord and Savior.



The color red in the bubble represents His blood. The Bible says, "There can no forgiveness of sins without the shedding of blood." The white color or clear bubble color, represents the washing away of sins. Jesus asks us to humble ourselves, admit that we sin, ask for His forgiveness and ask for Him to spiritually live inside us. It's amazing; once we do this we become a Christian and



begin a brand new life. If you've ever heard of someone saying that they're a born again Christian, that's what this is; having a rebirth, not in the flesh, but spiritually.

The green color in the bubble represents now this fresh journey with Jesus living in you. He calls you a new creation. I realized that this message was the purpose behind performing. From that point I produced a show called "Bubbles from Heaven" which presents the gospel to kids and their parents. It's so cool. When I tried it out in one church in West Monroe, the kids loved it, thus confirming to me this direction. I didn't stop performing parties, but continued to do both. When I do what I call "bubble preaching." LOL. Many



doors opened. One church leader would tell another from one denomination to another. "Bubbles From Heaven" went around New York State, Connecticut and into Canada. It was a hit! At the same time doors opened for school assemblies where I performed another bubble show to motivate students in their reading habits. Schools loved it and word of mouth continued. "Welcome to Bubblopolis!" is the wonderful world where my bubble characters come alive. There is Mayor ROY G BIV, the Mayor of

Bubblopolis!, little Sister Bubble, Big Brother Bubble, Baker Bob Bubble, Big Boy Bartholomew and Frederick Von Fruggle, the Mega Bubble! Each character is in a series of wands that grow in diameter from 10" to 36" in size. Through the presentation, the bubbles get bigger and bigger with the

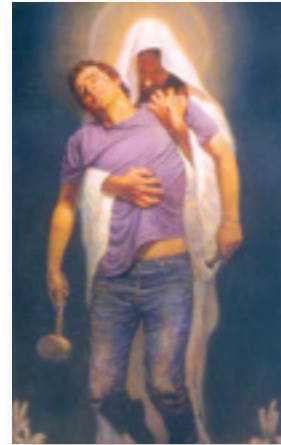
kid's excitement growing and growing. I hope you ask Jesus to come into your life today and learn to grow in what He has for you. Your life will completely change as you follow Him. He'll show you the same power He



lives in. The Holy Spirit empowered Him. You can be empowered too for God's glory and your enjoyment! One thing you should do is read the Bible to learn about Jesus. Praying



to Him is just the beginning. Now you can develop your faith in God. I recommend starting in the Gospel of John in the New Testament.

to live it out with Your help and none of my self will. I surrender to You today. In Jesus' name.
